1. CALL TO ORDER:

5. COORDINATOR UPDATE

Storage Unit – While the board was waiting for a credit card, the price increased.

Small Business Centre Walk – Candyce participated in walking with representatives from the SBC – they chatted with multiple businesses in the BIA.

Missing Garbage Can + Bike Rack – The missing garbage can and bike rack have been relocated to their location in front of Riverside Variety. The rack is missing a planter basket because the bike wasn't counted, but it will be included next time.

Watering Cart/Shed storage update – A BIA member on the adjacent property has been repeatedly moving the shed, which will cause damage. When against the dumpster, the shed gets damaged by the dumpster lids and gets maggots. We have asked the member to stop moving the shed and will come up with a more permanent solution to protect our asset if the member continues to move our property.

BIA Meet-up/Hosting – The BIA meet-up was hosted by Ford City a couple of weeks ago, Candyce, Markie and Laura all could not attend. Olde Riverside has asked if we could host the next one in the fall.

Wyandotte Street Construction – Candyce has touched base with the Gorgi Bro's Inc (Paving/Cement) and Enwin to see why the businesses and the BIA were not notified that construction was commencing on our sidewalks. Minimal response was given to Candyce.

Possible sewer construction will be happening in the next two years (mentioned previously by Councillor Joanne Gignac) which means Wyandotte street will be shut down for an extended period of time. Markie mentioned having a plan for marketing while that happens to make sure businesses aren't hurt during the construction season.

We ordered an additional 250 passports due to demand (originally ordered 250 qty).

Friday, July 11 is a kid-friendly focused afternoon with the magician and glitter tattoos over at the Running Factory/Duarte & Lesperance parking lots.

We have confirmed through insurance everything for our event is covered. Candyce worked with Chris Pistagnesi (Ives Insurance/Broker).

Pete said "Scenes From Dinner" came to his restaurant and did a promotional video, and it went great! Lots of interest in the passport, and it's been a great turnout thus far.

Lanterns – Candyce is going to come out at night to take an inventory of what is working/isn't working and on what poles. The city requires us to order any new lanterns from King Lumaires and the approximate price of each new fixture is about \$3,000 per one + installation. Once we have a plan for which ones aren't working and what the current style is, we can figure out what we want to replace and what we want to keep. Markie said perhaps the style of lantern we choose doesn't have the plastic casing around it to prevent them from getting broken or discoloured over time.
